We would like to ask that if you are able to offer support to those that need it, please do so. You could make a big difference in many small ways for example:

- Checking on your friends and neighbours
- Offering to collect food shopping or helping to set up an online delivery service
- Following Government advice and self-isolating if recommended
- Picking up prescriptions
- Dog walking
- Gardening and other outside jobs such as taking out/in the bins

If you need support please do not be scared to ask; whether you are running short of food or just need a friendly voice on the end of the phone, there are many willing volunteers who will be happy to help.

Register of volunteers

There are always people who use times of uncertainty to prey on others. Please do not open emails from sources you don't know. Do not give anyone your bank details or pin numbers.

Wetwang is a 'no cold calling zone'. This means nobody can go from door to door in village selling or promoting any goods or services. If you see anyone doing this type of activity you can report it to ERYC Trading Standards on 01482 393939
